## Emerging leader program seeks candidates for 2017-2018



The ACC Emerging Leaders program was developed to allow student and new professional leaders to become active and contributing members of ACC while receiving mentorship and developing leadership skills for the future of this particular Division of ACA.

Emerging leaders will be selected to serve for the 2017-18 term (September 2017-September 2018). A master's level student, doctoral level student, and new professionals (one in each category) will be selected as ACC emerging leaders. Recipients must be ACC members at the time of the application and be in the master's student, doctoral student, or new professional category at the time of their application. Emerging leaders will also have opportunities to learn the responsibilities associated with serving in elected leadership positions within ACC. They will also receive FREE conference registration for the 2017 ACC Conference.

In addition, emerging leaders will be mentored throughout their first year in the program and will them step into the role of transitional mentors for new emerging leaders the following year. Emerging leaders will have opportunities for participation and service throughout the year, such as help with conference preparation and at the registration table at the conference, participate on committees, possibly publish in the Clearinghouse and newsletter. Emerging leaders will be assigned a mentor, who will work closely with them in their primary area of interest.

- 4) **Two** letters of reference describing your leadership skills and experiences, and your value of creativity in counseling strategies and interventions (letters cannot come from members of the selection committee and references do not need to be ACC members).
